How many base station sites are there in Iceland



Overview

The short answer is no, there are no permanent, active US military bases currently stationed in Iceland. However, this doesn't paint the full picture. Does the US have a military base in Iceland?

However, the relationship between the US and Iceland regarding defense is complex and deeply rooted in historical agreements and ongoing security concerns. While a traditional, full-fledged base doesn't exist today, the US military maintains a significant presence and access to facilities in Iceland, primarily through the Keflavik Air Base.

Where was the Air Force base located in Reykjanes?

The base was located on the Reykjanes peninsula on the southwest portion of the island. The major commands stationed on the base were Naval Air Station Keflavik, the Air Forces 85th group, Commander Fleet Air Keflavik, Commander Iceland Defence Force, NCTS Keflavik, Naval Hospital Keflavik, and the Marine Corp Security Force Company Keflavik.

Where is the Air Force based in Iceland?

The base is located on the Reykjanes peninsula on the south-west portion of the island. There are more than 25 different commands of various sizes and personnel from the Navy, Air Force, Marines, and Army in Iceland. Also present are representatives from Canada, the Netherlands, Norway, and Denmark.

What military units are stationed in Keflavik?

The major commands stationed on the base are Naval Air Station Keflavik, the Air Forces 85th group, Commander Fleet Air Keflavik, Commander Iceland Defense Force, NCTS Keflavik, Naval Hospital Keflavik, and the Marine Corp Security Force Company Keflavik. There are also about 900 Icelandic civilians working in close coordination with duty members.

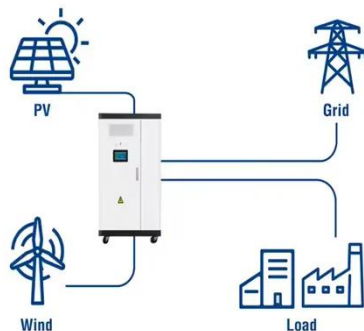
