What's new in Laos?

What's new: The construction of a massive renewable energy base by the China General Nuclear Power Group (CGN Group) in Laos is scheduled to begin in June, marking the start of the largest single new energy project in Southeast Asia. The project will become the first overseas clean energy base to send electricity back to China.

In 2023, the country exported 37,538 GWh of electricity, mainly.

How is electricity generated in Lao PDR?

ly, electricity generation from RE has steadily increased. In 2020, Lao PDR's energy consumption was primarily driven by the residential sector, which accounted for 35% of total usage. This was followed by the transport sector at 28%, the industrial sector at 25% and the commercial sector at 11%.
