Can you modify a lithium ion battery?

Do not attempt to modify lithium-ion batteries. Modifying lithium-ion batteries can destabilize them and increase the risk of overheating, fire and explosion. Read and follow any other guidelines provided by the manufacturer. Store lithium-ion batteries with about a 50% charge when not in use for long periods of time.

Do lithium batteries need to be fully charged?

The short answer is: No, lithium batteries do not need to be fully charged before first use. Unlike older battery technologies like nickel-cadmium (NiCd) or nickel-metal hydride (NiMH), lithium-ion batteries don't suffer from memory effect and do not require full charging before they become effective. That said, the context matters.

When should you recharge a lithium ion battery?

Contrary to popular belief, you don't need to wait until your device is completely drained before recharging. In fact, frequent partial charges are better for lithium-ion batteries. Keep the battery level between 20 and 80 percent in order to preserve battery health.

Does lithium ion battery care really matter?

Lithium-ion battery care doesn't have to be complicated. With these dos and don'ts, you can help your devices stay powered for a long time. Each small step, from maintaining regular charging habits to optimizing screen settings, contributes to the health and lifespan of your device's batteries.


